WAIVING EROSION CONTROL, SHORELAND EROSION CONTROL, AND ZONING FEES  
RELATED TO AUGUST 21, 2018 RAINFALL EVENT IN DANE COUNTY

On August 21, 2018 Dane County received record rainfall resulting in severe flooding in Dane County. Continued rainfall and rising floodwaters have damaged infrastructure, homes, properties, and businesses throughout the County. The owners of these properties will face tremendous costs in rebuilding, including fees for various county permits.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that erosion control, shoreland erosion control, and zoning fees shall be waived for applications to repair damage caused by flooding as a result of heaving rainfall in August and September 2018, to the extent possible and so as not to conflict with other applicable state and federal laws and regulations, particularly those pertaining to development and redevelopment in shoreland zones and floodplains.
